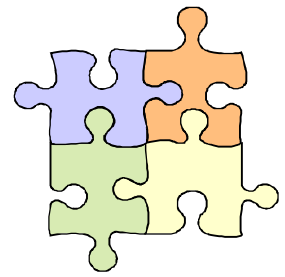


Pieces of the Girl Scout Puzzle



GIRL SCOUTS OF THE USA (GSUSA), headquartered in New York City, is a movement that gives girls a chance to develop their full potential, relate to others, develop values, and contribute to society. Based on the Girl Scout Promise and Law, the program opens up a world of opportunity for girls working in partnership with adult volunteers. The Girl Scout Program is designed to meet the particular needs and interests of girls.

GIRL SCOUTS – DIAMONDS OF ARKANSAS, OKLAHOMA AND TEXAS (GSDAOT), has an annual membership of 13,000 girls and 5,000 adults. Leaders/advisors are supported by administrative volunteers, the professional staff, and other Council resources.

The success of a girl's troop/group is directly linked to active, supportive adults.
